Polypersonal agreement

Verbs with subject agreement

c'a-vid-a [ča-ʒoɖ-a]

PREV-go-S.3(AOR)

's/he went'

v-dg-eb-I [3-ɖə-ɿ-ɔ]

S1-get up-THM-INDI(PRES)

'I get up'

Verbs with subject and direct object

(Ø)-xat'-av-en [bəθ-əʒ-əŋ]

(O3)-draw-THM-S.3PL

'they draw it'

v-i-(Ø)-q'id-e [z-ə-q'ɪd-ə]

S1-SV-(O3)-buy-AOR

'I bought them'

Verbs with subject, direct object and indirect object

mo-m-i-t'an-a (მო-მი-თანა)

PREV-O1-OV-bring-S3(AOR)

's/he brought it for me '

h-k'itx-a (ჰ-კითხა)

O3-ask-S3(AOR)

's/he Asked him/her that'

'you will get me to draw it/them'

'they have drawn it/them'

da-g-i-rek'-av-en (და-გ-ი-რეკ'-ავ-ენ)

PREV-O3-OV-call(FUT)-THMS-S3PL

'they will call you'

PREV	O3-O2	OV	do							S3.PL(AOR)

ga-(\emptyset)-g-i-k'et-es (გა-გ-ი-ქ'ეთ-ეს)

PREV-(O3)-O2-OV-do-S3.PL(AOR)

'they did it for you'

'they drew it for you'

(Ø)-i-geb-av-d-a (ი-გებ-ავ-დ-ა)

(O3)-SV-colour-THMS-IMPERF-S3

'S/he was coloring it/them'
